very informative meeting. You won't want to miss it!




Easter Egg Hunt—3/22/08

- Meeting Called to Order at 8pm Those present were Vi Anderson, Craig Wallace, Tom Sill, Susan Hill, and Heather Smith.
- Treasurer's Report—Tom presented the budget vs. actuals for 2007. Tom proposed moving the savings from ING Inc. into a money market account at Boeing for safety. Susan Hill moved and Heather seconded the motion. The BECU Money Market is not fixed but doesn't risk the principle, so still seems like a good investment. The amount in ING Inc cannot be taken out until Feb 4th, so the transfer will happen at that time. Lake Desire Water Main Replacement and Low Pressure Sewer Installations

According to the website at www.sooscreek.com, here is the update on this project:

This project is in design and is scheduled to begin construction in the summer of 2008. The 6" and 8"asbestos concrete water main around the lake was installed in 1965; it will be replaced with 8" ductile iron pipe, new water service lines, valves and fire hydrants.

Along with this replacement, the District will be installing a low pressure grinder pump system to convey sewage to an existing gravity sewer system. Upon completion of this work the roads around the lake will be overlaid.


